

## HOW IS THE ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION HELPING NORTH CAROLINA?

When you give to the Elks National Foundation, you're doing more than funding the Elks National Drug Awareness and Hoop Shoot programs. You're doing more than supporting the Community Investments Program and providing Emergency Educational Grants to the children of deceased or totally disabled Elks. You're doing more than maintaining the Elks Veterans Memorial.

You're doing all that, and you're supporting Elkdom in your state.

During the 2013-14 Lodge year, the Elks of North Carolina donated **\$87,072.39** to the Elks National Foundation. This year, the Foundation will give back the following:



State Charities Grant: \$58,100.00 Special Projects Grant: \$48,280.00 Bonus Grant: \$13,810.00

These grants help fund your state's major charitable project, as well as other philanthropic projects. Portions of these grants will also support your state's Drug Awareness Program, Hoop Shoot, Soccer Shoot and educational programs.



Most Valuable Student: \$32,000.00 Legacy Award: \$16,000.00

We will award a total of **eight** Most Valuable Student scholarships to high school seniors from your state. In addition, we will award up to **four** Legacy Awards scholarships to children, grandchildren or stepchildren of Elks.

National Veterans Service Commission: \$10,140.00



These funds will help Veterans Service volunteers provide care and comfort to hospitalized and homeless veterans.

## Grand Total: \$178,330.00

That's a ratio of **\$2.05** for every dollar the Foundation received from your state last year. And that doesn't even include the money Lodges in your state will get back through our **Community Investments Program**. For the 2011-12 fiscal year, for example, we awarded a total of **\$86,000.00** to **twenty-seven** North Carolina Lodges.

From inception in 1928 through March 31, 2012, the Foundation has granted a total of **\$4,344,818.18** to your state, compared with your state's total donations of **\$3,405,729.32**. That's a ratio of **\$1.28** for every dollar the Foundation has received from your state.

The Foundation's past support includes:

- \$1,877,200.00 in State Charities Grants
- **\$956,875.98** in Most Valuable Student Scholarships
- \$114,500.00 in Legacy Award scholarships to the children and grandchildren of Elks
- \$743,376.00 in Special Projects Grants
- \$193,342.41 in Emergency Educational Grants
